Wearing of brightly colored outer vest or belt (day) or reflective outerwear (night), sturdy over-the-ankle footwear, full-fingered gloves, long-sleeve shirt or jacket, long pants, protective eyewear, and DOT approved helmet. Awareness of most dangerous times and areas for riding, and motorcycle accident data. Other safety requirements can be instituted at the discretion of the commander.
