	6. ALL personnel on paintball range are wearing PPE: face mask (rated at 325fps or grater for PB), gloves, long sleeves, pants, neck protection, head protection, and combat boots.		
	7. Paintball Markers are properly adjusted as per AGCW PB SOP. <i>(Indoor: 260fps. Outdoor: 290 fps.)</i>		
	8. A vehicle is dedicated for MEDEVAC.		
Recommended Safety Measures <i>(Unit directed and supervised)</i>	9. A copy of the PB SOP is present at the site.		
	10. A signed Risk Assessment is present at the site.		
	11. All participants have been briefed on the potential hazards of using Paintball and have been taught to safely use Paintball equipment.		
	12. OIC/RSO conducts regular radio checks with Range Control. <i>(Every hour at the bottom of the hour.)</i>
