	10. There is a fire truck on site and/or the unit knows how to deploy fire assets on the range.		
	11. The range flag is up while the range is hot.		
	12. There is no one parked on upper parking lot at the POST bobber range.		
	13. Everyone is drinking water as per unit direction.		
	14. There are no unauthorized POV's on the range.		
	15. Has authorization from Range Control before going hot.		
	16. Unit is using proper weapons clearing device and is following correct procedures for clearing personnel off the range.		
	17. Ammunition and weapons are handled and stored properly at all times.		
	18. Before granting clearance to fire RSO follows proper procedures		
	19. Composite Risk Management Matrix published for this exercise.
