MOBILITY/SITE EXPLOITATION

The Site Exploitation training is a 40-hour course that includes how to conduct proper searching and TTPs, accurate intelligence and evidence collection and processing, and the duties and responsibilities of Site Exploitation/TQ team members. This training can be tailored to unit training providing practical exercises to introduce Soldiers to basic search, current best practices, and enemy TTPs, including the following:

- Site Exploitation (40 Hrs)
 - Person Search
 - Vehicle Search
 - Area Search
 - Building Search
 - Battlefield Forensics
 - Tactical Questioning
- Handheld Detectors
 - VMC1 (12 Hrs)
 - VMR2 (40 Hrs)

 - CMD V2.06 (8 Hrs)
 - Leaders Planning for Handheld Detector Integration & Operation (1 Hr)
- Man Portable Line Charge (MPLC) (2 Hrs)
- Route Clearance Operations (40 Hrs)
- Combined Arms Route Clearance Operations
 - Engineer Leaders (1.5 Hrs)
 - Maneuver Leaders/Staff (1.5 Hrs)

COIST

Company Intelligence Support Team (COIST) training (40 hrs) provides instruction in analyzing and exploiting information obtained from patrol briefings/debriefings, tactical questioning, biometrics, and site exploitation. Commanders designate four to six Soldiers per company to train as a COIST, receiving standardized training in the following basic intelligence disciplines, which the C12C trainer can tailor to the unit type and mission requirements.

- Intelligence Requirement Development
- Patrol pre-brief/de-briefs process
- Intelligence Support To COIN Operations Targeting
- IPB Orientation / Pattern and Link Analysis
- Intro to ISR Synchronization/Analysis skills/Dissemination
- Hybrid Threat

BIOMETRICS

The Biometrics training enables leadership to properly utilize the BAT and SEEK II within their scope of mission and teaches system users how to capture quality biometrics and troubleshoot potential problems.
