SUBJECT: Agenda for Brigade Command Language Council, May 2002

1. The Brigade Command Language Program Council will convene at approximately 1600 hours on Tuesday, 14 May 2002, in Monterey during DLI's annual Command Language Program Managers Seminar.
2. Agenda items to be discussed include:
 - a. Hot or Suspense Items.
 - (1) New CLPM. We will allow our new brigade CLPM to formally introduce himself.
 - (2) Language MTTs. Will still be hosting MTTs from DLI for Arabic, German, Russian, and Spanish from 2 to 15 June in Draper, Utah. We can still accept students in some of the languages.
 - (3) Linguist of the Year. We will discuss the brigade's Linguist of Year plan for FY02.
 - (4) Linguist Newsletter. Submissions are due 1 July 2002. Battalions should submit their 3/3 DLPT roster for the honor roll and are encouraged to submit at least one other article.
 - (5) ICC. We will proceed with conducting another iteration of the ICC during the first 2 weeks of August. We have approximately 10 seats available but need to solidify the student population as quickly as possible to allow DLI the maximum amount of time to tailor the course to our needs.
 - b. Regular Review Items.
 - (1) Technology. We will have a brief update on the CLP Web site and linguist database.
 - (2) Inventories. Battalions should report the status of their inventories of language materials.
 - c. Other Review Items from Past Meetings.
