



State Tuition Waiver (STW)

1. What is it?

The State Tuition Waiver Program was developed to aid Soldiers and Airmen of the Utah National Guard at all Utah State public universities and colleges. (UVU, USU, SUU, DSU, Snow, UofU, WSU, and SLCC) This is a competitive scholarship program based upon a student's academic standing. (Primarily Grade Point Average (GPA)) The program covers the cost of tuition equivalent to the full time rate of (12-18 credit hours) for the academic school year. This includes both semesters for **Fall** and **Spring**. To be considered for the State Tuition Waiver service members must submit an application between **January 1st and April 30th** prior to the year they will attend. There are a limited number of waivers at each school.

2. Eligibility: Senate Bill 109 limits eligibility to Utah National Guard members who:

- Have been accepted as a student at a Utah State public College or University for the current school year
- Will be attending school as a full-time student for the entire 2013-2014 school year
- Are MOS/AFSC qualified
- Do not have a 4-year degree
- Who are not on active duty (AGR/ADSW)

3. How Do I Apply?

- Complete the application for the Utah National Guard Tuition Waiver. (**State Tuition Waiver Application**)
- Submit a short essay describing your educational goals.
- Submit a copy of your school transcripts for every high school, college, or university that you have attended. Copies of your transcripts maybe unofficial (copied and pasted into a word document). The unofficial transcripts must have your name and the name of the school on the copy and pasted document.

4. Submit Application

- Once you have completed your application you may submit it via email to **ng.ut.utarng.list.education-office@mail.mil**. Application packets must be emailed no later than 30 April.
