### **Fort Douglas Military Museum Reopens for 2009 with New 'Utah War' Exhibit**

FORT DOUGLAS, Utah – Featuring newly added artifacts, a new exhibit, “Camp Floyd and the Utah War,” will be unveiled Saturday, Feb. 14, at 12:30 p.m. at the Fort Douglas Military Museum.

The Museum reopened to the public Feb. 3 after being closed since December.

Accompanying the opening of the new exhibit will be book signings by John Eldredge and John Nielson, authors of *Utah War: A Guide to the Historic Sites* and *Roll Call at Old Camp Floyd, Utah Territory*, respectively. Light refreshments will also be served.
