Fort Douglas Military Museum Opens Iraq Photo Exhibit

SALT LAKE CITY – The Fort Douglas Military Museum announces the ceremonial opening of a special exhibit, “Utahns in Iraq: Faces from the Front,” featuring photos by *Salt Lake Tribune* photographer Rick Egan, Saturday, April 18, at 12:30 p.m. at the Fort Douglas Museum.

Egan took the photos in 2005 during a two-month assignment in Iraq as he and *Tribune’s* Matthew LaPlante reported on various Utah-based Guard and Reserve units.

The ceremony will include remarks by Egan, as well as by Command Sgt. Maj. Bruce Summers, who was the senior enlistedman in the Utah Guard’s 222nd Field Artillery, one of the units Egan photographed while he was in Iraq.

Egan’s photos will be on display at the museum through December 2009.
