Camp Williams Conducts Artillery Exercise May 16

DRAPER, Utah – As previously announced, the Utah National Guard's 1-145th Field Artillery will conduct an artillery exercise Saturday, May 16, at Camp Williams.

The 1-145th (First of the 145th) will conduct its annual Crew Certification between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Saturday. The event is not open to the public.

Dates for subsequent artillery exercises at Camp Williams are as follows:

- Monday, June 1 – Friday, June 5, 2-222nd Annual Training
- Tuesday, June 16 – Wednesday, June 24, 1-145th Annual Training

On Wednesday, June 3, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., the media, public officials, and citizens are invited to observe the artillery exercises at Camp Williams. More details to be announced.

“It’s critical to our readiness that our Soldiers continue to train and prepare for their wartime mission,” said Lt. Col. Hank McIntire, spokesman for the Utah National Guard. “And we also want to be good neighbors by ensuring that residents in the area of Camp Williams know ahead of time that there may be some noise that they don’t normally hear.”

Those expected to be most affected by these events are residents of Bluffdale, Riverton, Herriman, Eagle Mountain, Saratoga Springs, and Lehi.
