### **Utah National Guard Holds First Camp Williams Advisory Board Meeting to Assist with Munitions Investigation**

CAMP WILLIAMS, Utah – The Camp Williams Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) is holding its first meeting Thursday, Feb. 25, at 6 p.m. at South Hills Middle School in Riverton.

The RAB, recently formed by the Utah National Guard, is a group of stakeholders and citizens who will work with the Utah Guard as it participates in the Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) at Camp Williams. The MMRP addresses munitions and explosives of concern that may be located on former training lands no longer owned by the Utah National Guard.

During this meeting, RAB members will be briefed on the upcoming field work to begin this spring. In addition, RAB members will be trained on their responsibilities and will begin drafting a mission statement and operating procedures.

The RAB includes members from Herriman, Bluffdale, Lehi, Saratoga Springs and Eagle Mountain, and also includes representatives from Hi-Country Estates Phase 2, a residential community in unincorporated Salt Lake County. Other stakeholders such as property owners and state regulators are also representing their organizations on the RAB.

RAB meetings are open to the public and are held on a quarterly basis in an effort to provide members and the public with updated information about the MMRP investigation taking place at Camp Williams.
