Utah National Guard Supports Scouting for Food Effort for 23rd Consecutive Year

DRAPER, Utah – For the 23rd consecutive year, the Utah National Guard will provide personnel and equipment support to the annual Scouting for Food effort Saturday, Mar. 27, in various locations throughout Utah.

Approximately 100 Airmen and Soldiers and more than 20 Utah National Guard vehicles will assist Boy Scouts from the Trapper Trails, Great Salt Lake and Utah National Parks Councils who will go house to house to gather donated food items for local food banks.

Guard members will be overseeing drop-off locations at the Ogden, Spanish Fork and Springville armories and will assist in transporting food items from these and other locations to the Ogden, Salt Lake, and Provo community warehouses.

“Helping those in need in our state is our primary mission, and it is an honor to partner with the Boy Scouts in this worthy cause,” said Utah Guard spokesman Lt. Col. Hank McIntire.
