Utah Guard Conducts Artillery Exercises

DRAPER, Utah — The Utah National Guard's Regional Training Institute will conduct artillery exercises Friday, April 23, through Monday, April 26, at Camp Williams. Firing will occur generally between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. each day.

"It's critical to our readiness that our Soldiers continue to train and prepare for their wartime mission," said Lt. Col. Hank McIntire, spokesman for the Utah National Guard. "And we also want to be good neighbors by ensuring that residents in the area of Camp Williams know ahead of time that there may be some noise that they don't normally hear."

The exercises are not open to the public.

Those expected to be most affected by these events are residents of Bluffdale, Riverton, Herriman, Eagle Mountain, Saratoga Springs, and Lehi.
