Utah Guard and City of Lehi Conducts First Community Covenant-Signing Ceremony

LEHI, Utah - The city of Lehi will be the first in Utah to hold a Community Covenant-signing ceremony Wednesday, April 21, at 7 p.m. in the Lehi High School gymnasium.
