151st Air Refueling Wing Hosts 47th Annual ANG bowling Tournament

SALT LAKE CITY – The 151st Air Refueling Wing will host the 47th Annual Air National Guard Bowling Tournament May 7 and 8 at the [All Star Lanes](#) in West Jordan.

Founded in 1962 by U.S. Air Force Sgt. John Hylton, the tournament is open to all ANG members, employees, retirees and family members.

“The two-day tournament features five-person teams, singles and doubles,” said Senior Master Sgt. Trent Moyer, 151st ARW member and tournament director. “Currently, we have 22 teams registered for the event.”

The original tournament location was in Martinsburg, W.Va., and was moved to Salt Lake City in 1965. From then on, the delegates voted to have the tournament rotate to different cities around the United States.

“The tournament should be a great opportunity for camaraderie with ANG members from across the country,” said Sergeant Moyer. “We have bowlers representing states as far away as New Jersey, as well as eight teams of our own.”

The tournament will take place at the All Star Lanes on 1776 West 7800 South, South Jordan. The event will run from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. May 7-8, with opening ceremonies starting at 9 a.m. on May 7. There will be a banquet and awards ceremony on May 8 at 7 p.m. at the Palms restaurant inside the Airport Inn. Media interested in covering the event can contact Lt. Col.
