Utah Veterans and Families Summit to be held March 30

DRAPER, Utah – The Utah Veterans and Military Employment Coalition, which is a partnership of several veterans benefits and services organizations, employers and civic leaders has partnered with the University of Utah Neuropsychiatric Institute to expand their annual Generations Conference at the Salt Palace Convention Center.
