Utah Guard's 1-145th Field Artillery Conducts Exercise at Camp Williams

The live-fire schedule will be as follows:

- Friday, May 4, between 12 noon and 10 p.m.
- Saturday, May 5, between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.

The crew and section-level training on the M109A6 Paladin howitzers will enhance readiness for members of the 1-145th Field Artillery to conduct their combat mission in both daytime and nighttime environments.
