SALT LAKE CITY – Dr. Jill Biden, Second Lady of the United States, will visit with Utah National Guard Airmen, Soldiers and families Tuesday, July 10, from 6 to 7:15 p.m. at the Utah Air National Guard Base in Salt Lake City.

Dr. Biden will be in Utah to raise awareness for Joining Forces, a national initiative that mobilizes all sectors of society to give our Servicemembers and their families the opportunities and support they have earned.
