Utah Guard Supports Scouting for Food for 27th Year

DRAPER, Utah – For the 27th consecutive year, the Utah National Guard will provide personnel and equipment support to the annual Scouting for Food effort Saturday, March 23, in various locations throughout Utah.

Maj. Gen. Jefferson S. Burton, adjutant general of the Utah National Guard, is this year's honorary chair for Utah's Scouting for Food.
