#### Utah National Guard to Break Ground for New Camp Williams Chapel

CAMP WILLIAMS, Utah – The Utah National Guard will break ground for a new chapel at Camp Williams Wednesday, June 5, at 1 p.m.

The new worship center, Sunrise Hall, will replace the World War II-vintage chapel that is currently in use at Camp Williams.

With an aesthetic design that will promote peace, serenity and renewal, the new 60,000-square-foot facility will feature a chapel for worship, seminar and conference rooms, chaplain offices, kitchen, and storage areas to more effectively meet the spiritual needs of the thousands of Soldiers who work and train at Camp Williams each year.

Because National Guard funds cannot be used for the building of military chapels, generous donors such as the Larry H. Miller Group of Companies, Zions Bank and The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints have made possible the construction of Sunrise Hall.

The new facility, to be built at a cost of approximately \$2.5 million, is designed by Bott Pantone Architects in Ogden and will be constructed by Stallings Construction, based in Murray. Projected completion date is sometime this fall.
