## Camp Williams Readiness Center Renamed for Fallen Utah Guard Soldier

CAMP WILLIAMS, Utah – The Utah Army National Guard's Camp Williams Readiness Center will be renamed the Scott B. Lundell Readiness Center in a formal ceremony Saturday, Aug. 24, at 1 p.m. at Camp Williams.

Lundell, a West Valley City resident, died in Afghanistan in 2006 after his dismounted patrol was engaged by enemy forces. He was a member of the Utah Army Guard's I Corps Artillery (Forward), which was sent overseas to provide training and support to members of the Afghan National Army.

In 2008, I Corps Artillery was reorganized and renamed the 65<sup>th</sup> Fires Brigade. The 65<sup>th</sup> is the unit overseeing Saturday's event.

Members of Lundell's family will be on hand at the ceremony.
