### **Utah Guard Engineers Return from Afghanistan Duty**

DRAPER, Utah – Approximately 25 soldiers assigned to the Utah Army National Guard's 204<sup>th</sup> Maneuver Enhancement Brigade will return to Utah from their 10-month deployment to Afghanistan Friday, Jan. 24, via commercial aircraft at Salt Lake International Airport.

Flight numbers and times are not yet available, but Soldiers are expected to arrive between 10:30 a.m. and noon at Salt Lake International Airport Friday, Jan. 24. More information will be announced as it becomes available.

The mission of the 204<sup>th</sup> was to conduct base operations and base defense for U.S. military installations in Northern Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

Soldiers arrived from overseas at Camp Shelby, Miss., last week and have been undergoing demobilization processing.
