

25B10 Pre-Assessment

This tool is meant to help instructors and students realize the current exposure and experience level the student has related to each of the eight skills and competencies so that the instructor and student may focus the student's development opportunities on those skills and competencies taught during the course. This tool is not meant to be used as a performance appraisal, but rather, in conjunction with the learning contract, as means to define the experience for the student and to establish a basic understanding of what skills the student hopes to gain as a part of his/her classroom experience.

Instructions:

1. Rank your current level of exposure and/or experience in each category below.
 - a. Use the following scale:
 - 0 = no exposure to and no experience in this competency
 - 1 = minimal exposure to, but no experience in this competency
 - 2 = moderate exposure to and minimal experience in this competency
 - 3 = moderate experience in this competency
 - 4 = experience in this competency
 - 5 = much experience in this competency, basic mastery has been achieved
2. Identify developmental opportunities (Routers, switches, network, security, etc.).
3. Meet with your instructor to discuss your pre-assessment and development opportunities.
